## Perfect Fit & Intu Blinds: What's the difference?

Perfect Fit Blinds and Intu Blinds are similar integrated blind systems and both are ideal for conservatories and uPVC windows and doors. They both avoid the need for drilling holes into your windows and doors and both are cord-free and child safe. Both systems provide a great choice in colours and styles of blind whether it be roller, venetian or pleated.

Perfect Fit Blinds are essentially a framed-based system that push fits between the glass of the uPVC window or door and the rubber-like material around the glass. The difference with Intu Blinds is that instead of having a frame, there is a headrail that fits onto the top of the uPVC window or door and there are side channels that keep the blind under tension.

To tilt the slats on a venetian blind, the Perfect Fit system uses a wand, whereas the Intu system uses a slider situated within the headrail. Both systems use a tab to raise and lower the blinds.
